



# Clearly Transferable

Judi's come up with a way to make clear photos to go with these trendy clear albums. Of course, with Judi, more is always better so she's adding an easy stitched photo journal to make the clear photos just "pop" off the clear pages of this album. All clear? Don't worry, Judi will clear things right up in this episode.

## MATERIALS

- Dye-Based Inkpads

- 12" each of Three Coordinating Ribbons

- Acrylic Block to Fit Unmounted Stamps
- 1/16" Hole Punch
- Tapestry Needle
- Fine-Tip Permanent Marker
- Detail Scissors
- Adhesive



## STARTING YOUR PROJECT

All of the tools and supplies for this project were stored conveniently in one 16" x 20" acrylic tray in the Old World Armoire from Collectors Cabinets. It holds up to 50 acrylic trays or can be customized to fit whatever type of craft needs you have.

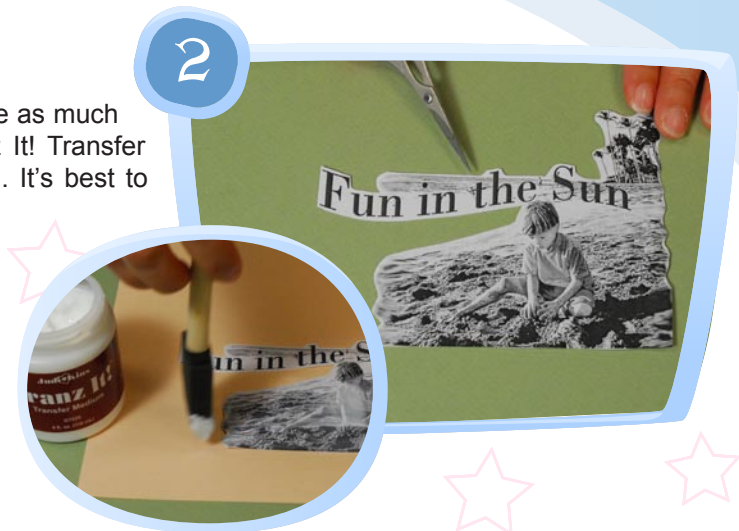


Make photo transfer for cover of Clear Scraps Tab Album. Choose photo and add title using computer program of choice. Print on laser printer using Tranz It! Rinse-Away Paper from JudiKins. You must use a laser printer.

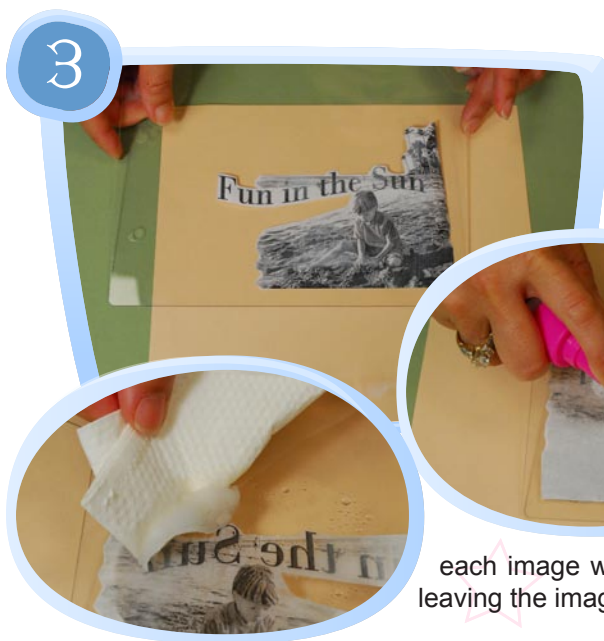
Because this paper is so thin, Judi recommends that you tape a piece of copy paper behind the Rinse-Away Paper for stability when going through the laser printer. Tape the Rinse-Away Paper to the copy paper at the top of both sheets. You can print on either side of the Rinse-Away Paper. Judi printed several images and tab labels on one sheet.

Cut out image for the cover. Trim the image to remove as much white space as possible. Apply a thin coat of Tranz It! Transfer Medium to the front of the image with a foam brush. It's best to apply the Tranz It! in one direction.

As you proceed with this next step, keep in mind the photo transfer will be applied to the back of the cover Panel. Peel the plastic liner from both sides of one of the 8" x 8" Panels of the Clear Scraps 8" x 8" Tab Album—decide ahead of time which Tab Panel will be the cover. Position the Panel over the wet image from Step 2 and carefully place the Tab Panel onto the image. Press with your fingers to insure a good bond.

Apply the Tab Labels printed out at the same time in the same manner on the three 8" x 8" Tab Panels. Turn the Tab Panels over so the back of the images are face-up on the work surface to dry.

When the images are dry, generously spritz the back of each image with water. The paper can easily be rubbed off with your finger—leaving the image behind on the clear Tab Panel. Let dry.

Squeeze about a quarter-size amount of Diamond Glaze on the backside of the image. Spread to the edges of the image with your finger. Let dry again. The application of Diamond Glaze seals the image onto the Clear Tab Panel from Clear Scraps and improves the clarity of the image.

Create the Decal. Scan and print out desired images on an Inkjet Transparency sheet. This time Judi printed out a variety of images in color. As the supplies indicate, this transfer technique uses an inkjet printer.

Apply 3 separate layers of Tranz It! Transfer Medium to the entire Transparency sheet. Apply the first layer horizontally to each image on the sheet with a foam brush. Let dry about 15 minutes. Apply the second layer of Tranz It! in a vertical direction to each image, again with a foam brush. Let dry for about 15 minutes. Finally apply the third layer of Tranz It! in a diagonal direction with the foam brush. Let dry for 15 minutes.

When the images are completely dry, trim one from the sheet leaving a generous border. Gently peel back the Tranz It! layers from the Transparency. Take your time for best results. Trim the image again.

Apply a thin coat of Diamond Glaze to the front of the Decal. Spread with your finger.

Remove the plastic liners from both sides of another 8" x 8" Tab Panel and place over the wet Decal. The Decal should be put on the back of the Panel so that it shows through to the front. Press into place with your fingers. Set aside to dry.

Create the Photo Journal. Download and print out the Photo Journal Template from [www.TVWeekly.com](http://www.TVWeekly.com). Trace the covers you want to use in your Photo Journal onto cream cardstock. Cut out as indicated by the Templates. The inside pages for the Small Photo Journal are 7" x 3½". The inside pages for the Large Photo Journal are 7" x 7". Cut as many pages as you need from cream cardstock.

Fold each page and the cover in half. Poke two stitching holes where indicated on Template in the cover and all pages. Do this one page at a time for accuracy. Nest pages together with cover on the outside.



Stamp focal point image with brown ink on front of panel. Adhere photos to the left side of inside pages. Ink large square cube with a combination of salvia blue ink and gray ink. Stamp square in center of page to the right of the first photo.

Mount "What is Fun?" Quote of choice from images included in the sheet of rubber from Stamp Camp onto acrylic block. Ink "What is Fun?" with dark brown ink and stamp in the center of the square stamped in Step 9. Continue stamping phrases throughout the Photo Journal. These quotes can be the springboard for your journaling or use them all alone as the actual journaling for your album.

Thread tapestry needle with one of the coordinating ribbons. Begin stitching from the outside through the cover and all pages to the inside. Bring the needle back out the other hole. Pull ribbon snug, but no so tight that you tear the paper. Tie into bow along spine.



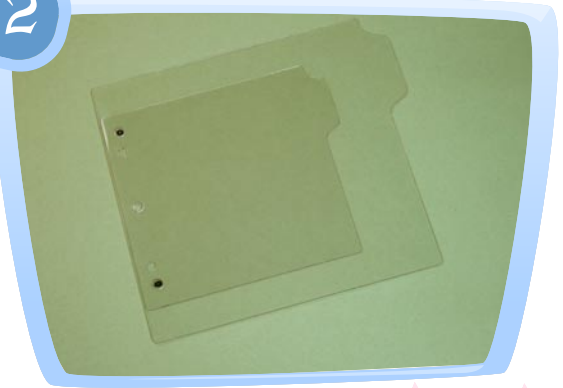
Judi created a total of 4 Photo Journals for this Tab Album. Two of the Photo Journals are the Small 3½" size. The third one is the Large Photo Journal Template and the fourth one is trimmed down to 2½" wide. By extending the sides you can create a wider and/or longer Photo Journal based on your particular album.

Judi used three 8" x 8" Tab Panels and two 6" x 6" Plain Panels from the respective albums from Clear Scraps. This leaves two 8" x 8" Plain Panels and three 6" x 6" Tab Panels for another project.

Putting the album together. Place one 6" x 6" Plain Panel behind one of the 8" x 8" Tab Panels—lining up the center holes. Mark the position of the two remaining holes on the 8" x 8" Tab Panel onto the 6" x 6" Plain Panel with a permanent pen.

Punch holes in the 6" x 6" Plain Panel where marked. Repeat for the second 6" x 6" Plain Panel.

Assemble the pages in the order they should be in the book. Bind the pages together with the binder rings that come with the Clear Scraps Tab Albums. Add coordinating ribbons to the extra holes in the 6" x 6" Plain Panels.

Flip the cover over as nothing else goes on that panel besides the clear photo from Step 3 above. Adhere one of the 3½" Photo Journals made in Step 9 above ⅛" from the bottom and ⅛" from the right side of the 6" x 6" Plain Panel with Trio Adhesive.

Turn the 6" x 6" Panel over. Adhere a tropical beach photo on the backside of the Photo Journal to cover the adhesive. The photo should be just smaller than the Photo Journal.

Adhere a Large Photo Journal to the front on the 8" x 8" Tab Panel that has the Decal from Step 8 on the back. Position the Photo Journal below the Decal. Judi stamped a Quote from Stamp Camp's "Peace" Quotes ("Peace is a gift of the Spirit") on the front of this Photo Journal. Adhere the Photo Journal with Trio Adhesive on the front Panel and cover the adhesive with a photo on the back of the Panel.

The next page is a 6" x 6" Plain Panel from Clear Scraps with a 2½" wide Photo Journal adhered to the left side of the Panel. Adhere a tropical photo on the back of the Panel to cover the adhesive.

The last page of the album has a 3½" Photo Journal adhered to the upper right corner of the Tab Panel. Judi stamped different sized squares from the Cube Square on this Photo Journal and added the Stamp Camp Quote "Fun is in the moment".

A decal of Judi snorkeling is adhered on the backside of the Tab Panel below the Photo Journal.

By adhering photos behind each of the Photo Journals Judi has cleverly covered up the adhesive while creating an album that is as much fun to look at from the back as it is from the front.
